Operation Lifesaver and Railroad Safety by Margret Cannell.

- Railroad offers a 4, 6, and 8 hour Law Enforcement Investigation Course. They also offer public safety courses for other emergency responders.
- Train don't typically run on schedule. They have scheduled times however are delayed regularly
- A train traveling 55 mph will take over 1 mile to stop.
- A weight ratio of 4000:1 versus a vehicle
- All crossings are required to have signage with crossing number and contact information. Telephone number 1-800-555-5555 to report any issues concerning rail crossings.
- Crossing notifications (bells, lights and cross arms) usually activate 17-20 seconds before arrives at your location
- Train Horns are not allowed for use at all crossings
- Train always has the right of way
- Don't pass, shift gears or stop on the crossing.
- Actual train is approximately 3 feet wide than tracks on both sides
